

Agreement and Terms of Use for Information Infrastructure and Services.

At the National University Corporation Institute of Science Tokyo, we provide various information services to support the study, research, and work of its students, faculty, and staff. In order to use these information infrastructures and services, we require the following agreements and consents. Please be informed of the following details.

1. Content Related to the Agreement and Consent for Use of Information Infrastructure and Services:
 - Comply with the relevant regulations of the Institute.
 - Adhere to the Science Tokyo Information Infrastructure Usage Guidelines (refer to the reverse side).
 - Understand that there are legal and social responsibilities associated with the transmission and reception of information and the use of information devices and software both inside and outside the Institute.
 - Refrain from actions that disrupt the stable operation of the information infrastructure or cause damage to third parties.
 - Acknowledge that in the case of improper use causing damage to the Institute or third parties, the individual responsible may bear the liability.
 - Consent to the Institute verifying personal communication logs and patterns if necessary for information security.
2. Content Related to the Consent for Providing Personal Information to Third Parties, etc., in the Use of Information Infrastructure and Services:
 - You acknowledge that personal information (such as email addresses and account names provided by the Institute) will be provided to SaaS providers, etc., in the use of information infrastructure and services provided by the Institute.
 - Understand that personal information (such as names, affiliations, email addresses provided by the Institute) will be disclosed to users of internal and external information infrastructure and services.
 - Recognize that accounts for using the information infrastructure cannot be suspended during enrollment or employment except for valid reasons.
 - Accept that account information and interactions will be retained in the applications even after account expiration due to graduation, completion of studies, or retirement.
 - You are prohibited from using personal information obtained through the use of the information infrastructure in an unauthorized manner.

The Science Tokyo Information Infrastructure Usage Guidelines

Science Tokyo Center for Information Infrastructure

The use of the information infrastructure and services provided by the National University Corporation Institute of Science Tokyo must not include any acts that violate applicable laws or regulations, or that are contrary to public order and morals. Furthermore, the following actions are prohibited unless approved according to the relevant regulations:

1. Please note that the use of the information infrastructure and services provided by the Institute is not permitted for commercial or religious activities.
2. In addition, the sharing of login or authentication information (login ID, password, matrix, etc.) with third parties is prohibited.
3. It is prohibited to connect devices with security issues (such as those with unsupported operating systems, lacking virus protection, or not updated) to the Institute's information infrastructure.
4. Any actions that impede the efficient operation of information systems within or outside the Institute, such as imposing an excessive load.
5. In addition, any actions that infringe on the confidentiality of communications, including potential acts, are prohibited.
6. The use of peer-to-peer (P2P) software or other equivalent communication software is prohibited.
7. Infringement of copyrights, including the unauthorized use of software, is prohibited.
8. Acts that constitute discrimination, defamation, insult, or harassment (including potential acts).
